IMPORTANT DATES

ANZAC Day - the 25th April each year.

Members of the RSA and the general public gather together for a parade, followed by a service and get-together at the Mosgiel RSA clubrooms.

Poppy Day - always observed on the Friday before Anzac Day, for over 100 years. Poppy Day commemorates the memory of those who died serving their Country. Funds from the sale of poppies go towards our Welfare service.

Armistice Day - 11th November marks the Anniversary of the signing of the Armistice that ended fighting on the Western Front and WW1. It commemorates the sacrifice of those who died serving their country in all wars and armed conflicts.
